Statement Commending NYU Gallatin Graduation Speaker Logan Rozos

ACT-UAW Local 7902 unequivocally stands in solidarity with and commends the courage and integrity of Logan Rozos (NYU '25), who, addressing the Gallatin School of Individualized Study commencement ceremony as the 2025 Graduation Student Speaker, denounced the genocide currently taking place in Palestine with the political and military support of the United States. Following the ceremony, the administration of President Linda Mills, never missing an opportunity to



cover itself in shame, issued a <u>statement</u> that, even by the Mills administration's dismal standards, is remarkable for its ghoulishness.

Local 7902 condemns the Mills administration's disgraceful display of turpitude in initiating disciplinary proceedings against Logan Rozos and threatening to withhold his degree because, to his great credit, he had the moral fortitude and strength of character not to be intimidated into silence by the administration's ruthless, entirely unprincipled, and one-sided suppression of free speech on the part of students, staff, and faculty when it comes to casting light on the atrocities being committed against the people of Palestine.

Local 7902 calls on the Mills administration immediately to terminate all disciplinary proceedings against Logan Rozos, to grant him his degree, and to issue a formal apology to him.

Once more, Local 7902 commends Logan Rozos, in the light of whose courage and concern for others the conduct of the university appears only the more callous, craven, and contemptible.
